Ottawa, Ont, Dec. 2—At the close of one of the most spectacular campaigns in the history of Cauadian politics, the National Liberal and Conservative Headquarters tonight rested its case with a declaration of confidence in the result. As many as one hundred and twenty sure seats are claimed for Mr. Meighen, some of the shrewdest observers in the Capital going so far as to declare that the combined King Wood-Crerar forces will not muster fifty seats out of one hundred and thirty nine that lie west of the Ottawa River.
