PROSPECTUS

I.—This Institution is under the control and management of the Priests and Brothers of the Congregation of Holy Cross.

II.—The studies are divided into two courses: the Commercial and the Classical. The commercial Course comprises four years; the Classical, five.

III.—No student is admitted to the study of the Classics before he has completed his Commercial Course. The French and English languages are taught with equal care.

IV.—In conformity with the rules of the Institution, great care is taken to impart the classical instruction in a thoroughly christian spirit.

V.—A pupil coming from any other institution, is required to produce a certificate of good conduct, signed by the president of that institution.

VI.—All mail-matter addressed to the students, or sent by them, is subject to the inspection of the President or his delegate.

VII.—Parents will receive a semi-annual Bulletin of the progress, application, conduct and health of their children, as also a statement of their expenses.

VIII.—Pupils entering after the commencement of the term are charged for the remaining portion only. No deduction, however, is made for a month already commenced,
