FOR THE YEAR 1858.

The Charitable Committee have to report that during the year past, relief has been afforded in One Hundred and Seventeen (117) cases, at an expenditure of £143 5s. 6d. currency, being an increase of 28 cases relieved over that of last year.

The heavy demands upon the Society, being likely for some time to continue, your Committee would again respectfully urge upon the Members of the Society, the duty of investigating into cases before recommending them for charitable relief.
