## POSTAL INFORMATION.

The Rates of Postage within the Dominion are-

For Letters, 3 cents per half oz. each.

For Newspapers (transient) one cent per 4 ounces; posted singly, one-half cent each, if under one ounce.

For Books, Pamphlets, Circulars, &c., &c., one cent per 4 ounces; the packet to be open at both ends for inspection.

For Parcels exempt from inspection, 6 cents per 4 ounces.

Pre-payment of the above, by affixing stamps, is required.

REGISTRATION.—To make transmission more secure, telters may be registered upon pre-payment of 2 cents each, and parcels 5 cents each.

POST CARDS are issued from all Post Offices at one cent each.

MONEY ORDERS are granted and paid at any Money Order Office in the Province: -for sums not exceeding \$4, two cents; not exceeding \$10, five cents; not exceeding \$20, ten cents; not exceeding \$40, twenty cents, &c.
