PRIVATE BILL

RAINBOW PIPE LINE CORPORATION— THIRD READING

On the Order for Tuesday, November 29, 1966:

Third reading of Bill S-52, intituled: "An Act to incorporate Rainbow Pipe Line Corporation". (Honourable Senator Hugessen).

Hon. John J. Connolly: Honourable senators, may I ask your indulgence. I should like to have unanimous consent to call now the first order of the Orders of the Day for Tuesday, November 29 next. It is the third reading of Bill S-52, entitled An Act to incorporate Rainbow Pipe Line Corporation.

This is a private bill which has been passed by the Standing Committee on Transport and Communications and which is standing for third reading.

I am informed by the sponsors that it would be a source of convenience to them if this bill could be given third reading and sent to the House of Commons. I see no objection to it and I hope it will meet with approval.

The Hon. the Speaker: Honourable senators, when shall this bill be read the third time?

Hon. Mr. Connolly (Ottawa West), for Hon. Mr. Hugessen, with leave of the Senate, moved that this bill be read the third time now.
