Is a shipbuilder, and Presdt. of the Hants Co. Marine Insur. Co. Sat in the Ho. of Assem., N. S., for Hants, from 1874 to 1878. First returned to Commons at g. e. 1887, and re-elected at last g. e. A Liberal-Conservative.—*Maitland, N. S.*

REID, JOHN DOWSLEY, M.D. (*South Grenville.*)

S. of the late John Reid, a native of Belfast, Irel., who came to Can. in 1845, and married Jane, dau. of the late John Dowsley, Prescott. B. at Prescott 1 Jan., 1859 and e.l. at Queen's Coll., Kingston. Unmarried. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Cardinal, Ont.*

RIDER, TIMOTHY BYRON. (*Stanstead.*)

S. of Ezra B. Rider, a native of New Hampshire, who settled in Stanstead in 1831 and took an active part in the early political history of the country. B. at Fitch Bay, Stanstead, 8 Jan., 1848. Ed. at Public school. M. 30 Nov., 1871, Mary E., dau. of Jacob Shaw. Is a general merchant, grist and saw miller. Has been a Town Councillor and Mayor for eight years, of Stanstead, and Postmaster at Fitch Bay. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal, and favours better trade relations with the United States.—*Fitch Bay, Co. Stanstead, P.Q.*

RINFRET, CÔME, ISIAE, M.D. (*Lotbinière.*)

S. of F. J. Rinfret, Esq., merchant, by C. Thibaudeau, a sister of the Hon. Isidore Thibaudeau. B. Sept., 1847, at Cape Santé, Co. Portneuf. Ed. at the Seminary of Quebec. M., Miss N. Laliberté, at St. Croix, in 1873. Graduated M.D., at Victoria Univ., Montreal in 1869. First returned to Parlt. at g.e. 1878. Re-elected at g.e. 1882, 1887 and 1891. A Liberal.—*St. Croix, Co.
