with the limitation that in no instance shall any employee work in excess of an average of forty-eight hours per week over a period of three consecutive calendar weeks. The Province shall keep complete records of the hours worked per day and per week by each of its employees on projects authorized by this Agreement and such records shall be available for inspection and audit by the Dominion.

9. The Province may supply the whole or any part of the materials necessary to execute and complete all or any parts of any of the projects authorized by this Agreement, but it is understood that the Province will not make any charge as against the Dominion for any timber, lumber or other materials supplied for the construction of said projects from the Crown lands of the Province except for labour or transportation costs necessarily incurred in respect of such of the said materials as are actually built into the projects during the term of this Agreement and except the reasonable cost of materials used from property bought by the Province for the purpose of procuring materials for use on any of the said projects. All materials shall be of Canadian manufacture if obtainable of suitable quality and price.

10. The Province agrees that it will maintain adequate records of all expenditures incurred pursuant to this Agreement, supported by proper documents and vouchers and that such records, documents and vouchers will be segregated from although reconciled with, the usual records of the Province. The Province further undertakes to make all or any of said records, documents and vouchers, available to the Dominion for audit or examination upon request and to furnish information in relation thereto.

11. Statements of accounts for expenditures made by the Province pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement, shall be submitted by the Province to the Dominion Commissioner of Unemployment Relief, accompanied by a certificate of the
