
Ottawa, 10th. September, 1904.

Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 6th. instant and in reply to inform you that your telegram thereby confirmed was duly received and the following answer was sent you by wire on 6th. instant, viz:- "Indian Commissioner fully instructed regard mange regulations".

In view of the matter having been left in the Commissioner's hands to deal with, it is unnecessary at this stage to discuss the details entered into in your letter, and the Department will <sup>only</sup> remark that your estimate of expenditure assumes the adoption of the practice of total immersion and ignores the alternative course of applying by hand or brush a prescribed mixture.
