Referring to your letter of the 9th instant (File No. 427,029-23) relative to certain vouchers returned to you which you state you are unable to complete until after the annuity payments, I beg to state that Mr. Inspector Bunn has been instructed to remain at Norway House after the payments and see that these vouchers are put in proper shape.

Mr. Bunn has also been requested to assist you to make out the vouchers accounting for the advance of \$4650.00 made to you for freighting and general expenses, as per letter of the 1st June last (File 427,036-23).

In that letter you were requested to forward a complete statement of the disbursements made by you on account of this advance before leaving for the annuity payments, but up to date, no statement has come to hand.

Mr. Bunn has been requested to see that these vouchers are brought down to date before leaving Norway House and to bring them with him to Winnipeg for transmission to the Department.
