



Ottawa, February 14, 1917

Sir,-

With reference to your communication of the 3rd instant, I have to inform you that the Provincial Order in Council permitting Indians to trap beaver and otter is only applicable to those living north of the French and west of the Mattawa rivers; no privilege of this nature has been extended to the Indians at the Chemong village.
