MEMORANDUM for Mr. Hudd, Canada House

The Mayor of Derby (Mr. Alderman Johnson) together with Mr. Alderman Armstrong and the Town Clerk, (Mr. Ashton) called at the Dorchester at half past two today and the Prime Minister signed the Roll of the Freemen of the Borough of Derby. Mr. Mackenzie King took occasion to thank these gentlemen for their courtesy in coming to London, and, in the name of the people of Canada, for the honour which had been done him in making him an Honourary Freeman of the Borough. He expressed the hope that on some visit to England he would be able to visit Derby to extend his appreciation in person.
