



Fig. 5 (left), a typical "Walter" left thumb print in wax, identical in pattern with the left thumb prints in Figs. 1 and 2, and Figs. 7 and 8 on the opposite page. It is indexed to show its identity with the ink print of "Kerwin's" left thumb seen in Fig. 6 (right).



Fig. 7 (left) presents another of the "Walter" left thumb prints in wax made during the same sitting as the print shown in Fig. 5. This wax has been continuously in the custody of Mr. Hutchinson, until it was lent to Mr. Carrington for photographing. Note broken edge of wax.

Fig. 8 (right) shows that part of the wax of December 3, 1927, carrying the "Walter" left thumb print in wax.
