

- Q-63. What did Sgt Featherstone say to Gnr McKinnon ?
A-63. He said he didn't want anything to start here and took Gnr McKinnon by the right arm.
Q-64. And where did he take him?
A-64. He took him outside.
Q-65. Did the accused show any resistance ?
A-65. No, sir.
Q-66. What did you do ?
A-66. I followed them out, sir.
Q-67. Just tell the Court in your own words what you saw ?
A-67. Gnr McKinnon was ahead of Sgt Featherstone and as he got to the door and stepped outside the door Gnr McKinnon struck him. He fell out the door on his face.
Q-68. You saw the Sgt being struck ?
A-68. Yes, sir.
Q-69. How far away were you ?
A-69. I was standing my back to the wall.
Q-70. Where did the accused strike the Sgt ?
A-70. On the left cheek, as he was stepping out the door.
Q-71. You said that Sgt Featherstone then fell down and cut his forehead ?
A-71. Yes, sir.
Q-72. While Sgt Featherstone was falling, what was Gnr McKinnon doing?
A-72. He was standing next to Sgt Featherstone while he was holding his Arm.
Q-73. Did they both fall together ?
A-73. Yes, sir they did.
Q-74. Who got up first ?
A-74. Gnr McKinnon, sir, I couldn't say for sure, but Sgt Featherstone was helped up.
Q-75. Did you notice at that time that Sgt Featherstones forehead was cut ?
A-75. Yes, sir.
Q-76. Did McKinnon appear to have any cuts or bruises on his face ?
A-76. No, sir, not that I could see.
Q-77. How far were you then ?
A-77. I was about 4 or 5 paces away, sir.

Cross examined by the Defence.

- Q-78. Was Gnr McKinnon inside or outside the Hotel when he allegedly struck Sgt Featherstone ?
A-78. He was inside, sir.
Q-79. Sgt Featherstone was he inside or outside the Hotel ?
A-79. He was just going out.
Q-80. How were they going out ?
A-80. Gnr McKinnon was ahead until they reached the door, then the Sgt stepped ahead of Gnr McKinnon.
Q-81. You were right behind the two ?
A-81. I was about a pace behind them.
Q-82. Was there anybody else close to him ?
A-82. There was a chap next to.....I was inside.
Q-83. Could he have not hit the Sgt ?
A-83. No, sir, he was not in a position to hit the Sgt.
Q-84. Did Sgt Featherstone have a hold of Gnr McKinnons arm when they left the Hotel ?
A-84. He had a hold of Gnr McKinnons arm when he went to fall, and then he let go.
Q-85. Did you see Sgt Featherstone take a drink ?
A-85. No, sir.
Q-86. Could Sgt Featherstone have taken a drink without you seeing him?
A-86. I wouldn't say he didn't, I didn't see him take a drink.
Q-87. Sgt Featherstone could have had a drink without you seeing him?
A-87. He could have as far as I was concerned, I haven't seen him taking a drink.
Q-88. The person that Sgt Featherstone took outside before taking Gnr McKinnon would you recognize him ?
A-88. Yes, sir.
Q-89. Do you know his name ?
A-89. No, but I could recognize seeing him again. I cannot remember his name.
