

100 inches of water for
Chase's dam

the Thompson River opposite Reservoir
Reserve No. 1

* All the water the Indians require from
the Creeks which flow into the South Thompson
River near the house of Mr Chase, subject
to the requirements of white settlers who
have reserved water from said Creeks.

Pat-jo-hal-then Reserve, Adams Lake Indians, On

the North Bank of the Thompson River,
all the land from Little Lake to the
Reservoir Reserve except Walker's claim.

* All necessary water from Reservoir Lake
and from the Creek forming the Western bound
of this Reserve, subject to the rights of the
Reservoir Indians and to those of white settlers
who have reserved water. (13 Aug. 1874)

The Reserves set apart for the Lower Nicola Indians
the following lie within the 20 mile belt.

Washkan Reserve on the Nicola River embracing
the mouths of the Popsailqua and Washkan
streams

Washkan Reserve - Near the "Potato Gardens"
Nicola Valley between the Washkan and Wash-
kan streams.

Popsailqua Reserve. At the junction of the
Washkan and Popsailqua streams.
