SEPTEMBER.—In America we have now had thirty years' experience with the wheat-midge. We have become well acquainted with its history, its transformations and its habits. The best remedies for it are but partly efficacious. It continues to be as numerous and destructive now as it has been at any previous period. By diminishing the yield of wheat crops, it is occasioning a loss of millions of dollars annually. This loss will continue until by the hand of man the parasite destroyers of this insect become introduced into this country, when it will disappear, in the same manner that its predecessor the Hessian fly has disappeared.
