

The new Red Cross Liner Silvia, Captain Mitchell, arrived from Glasgow at 3 p.m. yesterday, after a very stormy trip across, head winds being encountered all the way. The Silvia, which is a two-funnelled ship, berthed at the Furness pier where a large gathering of citizens were present and all were pleased with her graceful lines and fine appearance. She is fully equipped in every particula: both as a passenger and freight car rier and those who travelled by her are loud in their praise of her as a sea-boat. The ship has accommodation for 180 first class passengers and 50 second class. Her staterooms and cabins de-luxe eclipse anything that has yet been seen on this service being large and comfortable. The dining saloon is forward of the staterooms. and is handsomely fitted, the furniture being of mahogany, upholstered in blue plush, while it has seating accommodation for 80 persons. Above the saloon is the music room which is elaborately fitted. The smoking room is further aft, and is nicely upholstered in red morocco, with light oak finishing. It is easily accessible from the staterooms or saloon and has all the latest conveniences for ocean travel. In every particular the Silvia has been fitted to meet the requirements of the service and she will undoubtedly tend to increase the volume of traffic on the St, John's Hansax and New York route. The officers quarters are also in keeping with the general efficiency of the ship, whi: the crew's requirements and comforts are similarly looked after.
