

The chef prepares each dish in its proper order and has it ready waiting on a tray. When the host and his guests are seated at the table, the former touches a button and the elec trically operated trav arrives through a trap door in the top of the table When closed this trap looks like two ordinary silver covers on the table. By pressing another button, the tray, with its dish, is carried around the central portion of the table. As the

dish arrives in front of each guest the host touches a third button which stops it while the guest is helping himself. The dish passes all around the table in this way, and then, on again pressing the first button, it disappears through the table and returns
