Washed Coffee Cream - Sweeten one pint of cream rather liberally; roast two ounces of coffee beans; when they are lightly browned throw them into the cream and let the dish stand an hour before using; it strains and whips the cream to a firm froth.

Beef à la Chateaufort - Take a large or double tenderloin steak and broil it; have good potatoes parboiled; cut the potatoes into thin slices; mix a little parsley cut fine; add the juice of one lemon; mix thoroughly and pour over your steak.
