

The contract for Hamilton firemen's clothing was awarded by the council to Wm. Wilson & Son, but it has since been discovered that the lowest tenderer had been inadvertently passed over, viz., Frank & Co. The question is to be re-considered.

Crawford, all of Winnipeg, will shortly apply to the Manitoba Legislature for a charter incorporating them as the "Central Dry Goods Company (Ltd)". The object for which incorporation is sought is to buy, sell and deal in dry goods, millinery, men's furnishings, and all other kinds of goods, wares and merchandise. Winnipeg is to be the chief place of business, and the amount of the capital stock is fixed at \$25,000, divided into 250 shares of \$100 each. The applicants are to be the first directors of the company.

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
