



NOTES CONDENSED.

(d) Two moves are advocated as best—the text, and P—Q 4. Ponziani's counter gambit, 3. P—K B 4, is now held to be more than met by 4. P—Q 4! As for Black's 4. K Kt x P is certainly best.

(e) 9. P—Q B 3 was decidedly worthy of attention.

(?) We can but think this ill-advised, almost to fatality. This isolated B P, coupled with the badly posted Kt, becomes substantially the source of all Black's subsequent troubles, 10. P—Q 3 seems good.

(f) Obviously not 19. Q x Q B P, for B x Kt P!; followed by Black 20. Q—Kt 4, or 5, with a winning attack.

(g) Forced; 25. R—Q B sq is not available on account of the pinning of Black Kt when the White one moves. Black's game, however, is virtually hopeless.


