#### DEPUTY MINISTERS.

- 10 **49.** (1) There shall be a deputy head for each department, who shall be appointed by the Governor in Council, and shall hold office during pleasure. Deputy Head for each Department.
- (2) No officer shall hereafter be raised to the rank of deputy head except in the case of a vacancy occurring or when a new department is created by Act of Parliament. Parliamentary authority necessary to create.

- (3) Whenever a deputy head is removed from his office, a statement of the reasons for so doing shall be laid on the table of both Houses of Parliament within the first fifteen days of the next following session. 1906, s. 52. Statement when a deputy head is removed from office.
- 50.** (1) The deputy head of a department shall, subject to the directions of the head of the department, oversee and direct the officers, clerks and employees of the department, and shall have general control of the business thereof, and shall perform such other duties as are assigned to him by the Governor in Council. Deputy head to direct Department subject to head.
- 25 (2) He shall give his full time to the public service, and shall discharge all duties required by the head of the department, or by the Governor in Council, whether such duties are in his own department or not. 1906, s. 59. His full time to be given.
