In your Note of May, 1957, you informed me that the Government of Canada proposes, subject to the concurrence of the Government of India, to modify the agreement regarding the entry to Canada for permanent residence of citizens of India which was concluded by an Exchange of Notes on January 26, 1951.

I have the honour to inform you that the proposals set forth in your Note are acceptable to the Government of India and I confirm that your Note and this reply constitute a modification of the agreement of January 26, 1951, between our two Governments.
