- Current status of special equipment that was used for chemical weapons production.
- 4. Dates of conversion from CW use, date of beginning of non-CW use.
- 5. Current ownership, operation and control.
- 6. Current production, stating types and quantities of product(s).
- Current capacity of the facility, expressed in terms of the quantity of end product that can be produced in (period), assuming the facility operates (schedule).
- 8. Current detailed facility description:
  - (a) Layout of the facility.
  - (b) Process flow diagram.
  - (c) Location of any CW-specific equipment remaining on-site.
  - (d) Quantities of any chemical weapons remaining on-site.
- C. <u>Declarations of [existing] chemical weapons production facilities under</u>
  the control of others on the territory of the State Party
  - Responsibility for declarations (to be discussed).
  - All elements contained in part IA of this Annex should be declared.
- D. <u>Declarations of former chemical weapons production facilities under the control of others on the territory of the State Party</u>
  - Responsibility for declarations (to be discussed).
  - All elements contained in part IB of this Annex should be declared.
- E. Declarations of transfers
  - Chemical weapons production equipment means (to be developed).
  - 2. The declaration should specify:
    - (a) who received/transferred chemical weapons production equipment [and technical documentation];
    - (b) the identity of the equipment;
    - (c) date of transfer:
    - (d) whether the chemical weapons production equipment [and documentation] were eliminated;
    - (e) current disposition, if known.
