

REGULATION OF THE IMMUNITIES OF DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR PERSONNEL

The Office of Protocol of the Department of External Affairs regulates the immunities of diplomatic and consular personnel in Canada in cooperation with the provincial and territorial offices of protocol, which deal with matters within their jurisdiction.
