

- (c) Suffield airstrip (use by the United Kingdom to be restricted to light fixed wing aircraft and helicopters, and occasionally Hercules or similar type aircraft having regard to the condition of the airstrip);
- (d) the cafeteria on the base;
- (e) heating, water, electricity, sanitary and storm sewerage, and gas facilities;
- (f) the Primary School;
- (g) medical;
- (h) communications services including the means of transmitting and receiving secure telecommunications; and
- (i) the Community Centre, Ralston Village.

5. Canada shall supply or act on behalf of the United Kingdom in obtaining the following supplies, facilities and services when required by the United Kingdom:

- (a) radio frequencies;
- (b) canteen facilities;
- (c) rations;
- (d) fuel and lubricants;
- (e) furniture and fittings;
- (f) maps of training areas;
- (g) hard targets; and
- (h) civilian labour.

6. A building is to be constructed for DRES use and paid for by the United Kingdom in exchange for Building No 210 (Hangar).
