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ERRATUM.

In making the calculations of the Moon's Changes, the Compiler regrets to find that in converting English time into Newfoundland time he has inadvertently added, instead of deducting the difference between them—viz., 3h. 31m. The error is therefore ~~some~~ ^{now} corrected, and may be readily corrected by subtracting (which the reader is requested to do in each case) 7 hours and 2 minutes from the respective times given for every Moon—thus: the time of the New Moon in January is stated to be at 4h. 16m. A.M. on the 17th, whereas it should be on the 16th day at 9h. 16m. P.M.;—and the same throughout.

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
