A little attention to this matter, will dispose those who have made a practice of passing the Post-houses, to do as they would be done by.

The paltry consideration of saving a few pence, or the selfish motive of more ease, will vanish when one considers that the practice complained of will in the end deprive the public of the great benefits arising from a well regulated Post.
