Sec. 2. Every member shall pay into the funds the sum of Twenty cents monthly.

Sec. 3. The dues of sick members (unless otherwise paid) shall be deducted from their relief allowance.

Sec. 1. A Low Mass will be offered by the Spiritual Director every Saturday for the benefit of the living and dead members of the Society.

Sec. 2. A Low Mass will be offered for every deceased actual member within the week following his death.

Sec. 3. All members when sick shall be entitled to the sum of Two Dollars per week, not exceeding eight weeks in any twelve months.

Sec. 4. On the decease of any actual member the Society shall expend, as relief, in money or otherwise, as it may deem proper, the sum of Twenty Dollars, to defray funeral expenses.

Sec. 5. On the decease of any actual member the Recording Secretary shall, upon being notified, give notice through the public press of the time and place of the funeral; and the members will be expected to attend the same.
