If you would overcome sin, and live a victorious life, full of peace and joy in God, surrender yourself absolutely to Christ and let the Holy Spirit control your will. Then the power of God in your life will bring continual delight. "Walk in the Spirit and ye shall not fulfil the lusts of the flesh."
