Why He is Encouraged.

Commissioner Pepper gives five specific causes for a feeling of encouragement, among them action by Mexico on the north and the Argentine Republic on the south, to extend their railway lines; the settlement of disputed boundaries; the law passed by the Chilean congress for the tunnel thruthe Andes to enable railway connection between Buenos Ayres and Valparaiso; legislation by several of the republics, with a view to offering greater inducements for foreign capital to engage in railway construction; definite determination of the Panama Canal question.

Commissioner Pepper discusses the great progress in railway work in Mexico. Reference is also made to inter-oceanic lines from the Gulf of Mexico to the Pacific, and it is stated that within two years two trunk systems will be completed.
