CORN AND OATS ARE FIRM WHEAT CONTINUES WEAK

Chicago Market Shows No Change From Recent Trend—Liverpool Also in Line.

Liverpool wheat futures closed today unchanged to 1/2 lower than yesterday.

135 CARS AT CITY YARDS GREAT BRITISH FLEET

Over Three Hundred Vessels With an Aggregate Complement of Nearly 70,000 Men.

LONDON, June 30.—The mobilization of all British warships in home waters available for immediate service was completed today for the annual naval manoeuvres, and Admiral Lord Charles Berosford found himself in supreme command of a total of not less than 301 ships with an aggregate complement of 68,000 officers and men.

Local pride in the record size of this fleet is pronounced, and the array of ships in the North Sea is no maner connected with Germany, do not in the least detract from the grandeur of the fleet over assembled in the history of the world.

Officially, all thought of reproducing the spectacle of the German fleet in the event of difficulties with Germany is repudiated, but from the general character of the German fleet it is not surprising that Admiral Berosford, with the channel fleet and the first cruiser squadron based at Aalborg, is to enact the part of the eastern coast of Great Britain, which Admiral Bridgman, commander-in-chief of the home fleet, with its base in the Firth of Forth, has to defend.
