I have the honour to submit herewith minutes of band meeting of the Ucluelet Band, in which they request a distribution of the remainder of timber money due them ~~for~~ sale of their timber on Kley Kley House reserve.

Referring to your letter of January 2nd, 1936, file no: 30159-29, there remains an undistributed balance of \$1769.00, and it is this balance the band refer to. The Ucluelet Band are all fishermen, and request this money for the purpose of repairing their boats and replacing gear for the coming season. As they are showing themselves industrious, and are making a real attempt to be self supporting, this request is respectfully recommended.

Number of shares at the moment will be 146, which at \$12.00 would amount to \$1752.00.
