**FIRE BROKE UP FOUR LODGES**

Lady Foresters, Knights of Pythias, Hebrew Society and Fraternal Conclave Desert Meetings Clad in Regalia

New York, July 23—A small fire in the Colonial building at Nos. 67 and 69 West One Hundred and Twenty-fifth street last night did \$100,000 damage, but it broke up four lodge meetings, one of which was the Washington Irving Circle of Lady Foresters. The fire started in the kitchen of the building, which is a five-story structure, and spread to the second floor, where it was taken up by a shaft of the building. The second floor was used as a lumber and store room, and that is where the fire broke out.

Last night at 9 o'clock the Washington Irving Circle of the Lady Foresters, 100 strong, was meeting on the third floor, the Fraternal Conclave of the Knights of Pythias was in session on the fourth, the Beth Shalom Hebrew Society, a Hebrew benevolent society, was on the fifth and the Fraternal Conclave was in session on the sixth.

The fire started in a pile of greased rags on the second floor, some time early in the evening and it spread slowly. That is why some sharp-nosed sister informed Mrs. Della Thomas, who was presiding over the Foresters, that the smoldering elevator man was busy.

Mrs. Thomas is cool, and she calmed the circle with the assurance that it was a mistake. A few minutes later the fire had spread to the second floor, where it was taken up by a shaft of the building. The second floor was used as a lumber and store room, and that is where the fire broke out.

**MASONIC GRAND LODGE OF ONTARIO**

In Session at Belleville — Over 600 Delegates in Attendance — Reports Show Satisfactory Progress

Belleville, July 22—The Masonic Grand Lodge opened in the Armories here Wednesday. The principal event of the morning session was Grand Master MacWatt's address, as well as the reports of the grand secretary and grand treasurer. There are over 600 delegates in attendance, the strike on the Grand Trunk preventing about 90 from coming. Every hotel is crowded, while many are domiciled in private residences.

At the opening today, Mayor Marsh read a civic address of welcome accompanied by City Clerk Mikel, K. C. An address of welcome on behalf of the city local Masonic lodge was read by R. W. Bro. Arthur McGinnis, after which a reception was given by Mark W. Bro. J. Cameron, grand master of the Grand Lodge of Quebec, and Bro. W. H. Whyte, grand secretary of Quebec province. The reception of representatives in the Grand Lodge of Foreign Grand Lodges followed.

The committee on benevolence reported showed receipts up till May to be \$41,397.38; expenditures, \$38,772.18. The total assets amount to \$109,882.31. The sum on hand for the semi-centennial fund amounts to \$73,809.63.

The committee on benevolence reported that during the year they made interim grants to applicants amounting to \$845,224.25. Being a chairman of the committee. Other reports read were those on the condition of Masonry, by Col. Ponton; grand supplies, by George Galt; on constitution and laws, and the committee on warrants.

**DANGER OF BEEF FAMINE ENDED**

Rangoon, July 23—The danger of a beef famine in Rangoon, because of the strike on the Grand Trunk railway which went into effect at 9:30 o'clock Monday night, was ended Friday, when four carloads were received in the city from Danville Junction, consigned to the local branches of the Chicago wholesale beef house. Even though the strike should continue indefinitely it is not thought that there will be any further trouble with the beef supply here. From now on all cars will be shipped from Chicago to Rangoon via the Canadian Pacific. They will be transferred to the Bangor & Aroostook at Brownville and brought to the city via Northern Maine Junction.

The situation has been serious here ever since last Monday, when Armour & Co., Swift & Co., and the Schwartzchild & Sulzberger Co. have all been hampered in filling their orders. For a day or two the supply of fresh beef has been practically exhausted. Two cars which had been shipped from Chicago to the Bangor branch of Armour & Co., which were due to arrive Tuesday or Wednesday, were caught in the general hold-up on the Grand Trunk and but little could be found of their whereabouts.

**BIG AVIATION MEET IN BOSTON**

Boston, July 23—Recently received news of famous aviators, as well as their assured financial status, promises to make the Harvard-Boston Aviation Meet which will be held on Soldiers Field, September 2-13, an epoch-making event in aerial history.

Fifteen professional aviators, including Glenn Curtiss, Guy F. Hamilton, one of the Wright brothers, and O. P. Willard have entered. At least three foreign aviators will compete, using Blériot and Antoinette monoplane. Besides the professional a large number of amateur aviators and designers will exhibit and some of them will attempt flights. Charles J. Glidden, president of the Aero Club of New England, and once president of the Aero Club of America, will make sessions in the New Boston. He has already made five sessions.

With the meet still more than a month off, Boston merchants have contributed \$30,000, absolutely insuring the financial success of the meet.

**ARRESTED FOR SETTING FIRE TO A HOUSE**

Charlottetown, P. E. I., July 23—(Special)—Hugh Turner, of Tynes Valley was lodged in Summerside city jail last night charged with setting fire to the residence of his brother-in-law, Frank Riley. The house was burned to the ground with all its contents during the absence of the inmates, last Friday. This is the second time Riley has been burned out of his home. Frank McDonald, aged fourteen, of Boston, who is visiting his uncle, Angus McDonald, at Tynes, will probably be the sight of his right eye as a result of an explosion of a revolver cartridge which jammed in the chamber which he was hammering into position.

**INSURGENTS ATTACK TOWN IN NICARAGUA**

San Juan Del Sur, Nicaragua, July 23—The towns of Nadanias, 35 miles to the south, and Canoaqui, fifty miles to the east of Managua, were attacked simultaneously by the insurgents on Thursday. Each attacking force numbered about 400 men. The revolutionists were repulsed. General Valdes, the government commander at Canoaqui was seriously wounded in the fight there and only the opportune arrival of reinforcements at Nadanias saved the day for the government.

**BUILDINGS READY FOR EXHIBITORS ON AUGUST FIRST**

This Will Give a Full Month for Preparing Displays—Many New Features—More Room Provided for Sightseers

The exhibition buildings have been entirely transformed with a very tasteful decorative scheme of colors both inside and out, and a week from Monday—August 1st—they will be handed over to the vast number of exhibitors for final preparation for the grand opening on Saturday night, September 3rd. This is an almost unprecedented condition of affairs and proves the wisdom of starting operations so far back as January last. A careful inspection of the grounds and structures by the manager yesterday, elicited the fact.

One of King county's most prominent breeders, on inspecting the cattle facilities during the past week, was so impressed and surprised at the modern arrangements and thoroughly convenient with up-to-date facilities, having visited all the important points of the eastern section of the province during recent years, he paid the St. John Exhibition Association the compliment of writing a letter to the effect that the capital sum of \$120,000, \$20,000 in 1908, and \$2,500.00 in 1910. The total grants for the year just closed amount to \$20,500.00.

The lodges have paid into the semi-centennial fund during the year ended 31st May, 1910, \$18,282.28, an increase over the former year's contributions of \$10,855.97. During the month of June, 1910, there has been paid in an additional sum of \$4,500.00, and \$24,782.28 in 1910. The grants for the year ended 31st May, 1910, were \$43,000; on 31st May, 1910, it stood at 45,000, an increase for the year of 2,100, with 413 lodges on the roll.

On 31st May, 1904, 387 lodges were liable to contribute to the semi-centennial fund, and up to 31st May, 1909, only 87 had paid their quota in full. Last year 88 lodges were added to this list, so that on 31st May, 1910, 475 lodges had paid in full, and 200 have yet to pay. At present only 37 lodges have not contributed at all.

**Grand Lodge Unwieldy**

Of the proposal to reduce the membership of the grand lodge, the grand master said: "There are 3,500 or more, past masters who are members of the grand lodge, so something must be done, and soon, and there are adding to this number several hundred yearly. If not, the grand lodge will be compelled to hold its annual communication in Toronto, the only place at present where there is ample accommodation."

There were granted two dispensations for new lodges, University, Toronto, and King George V., Coburn.
