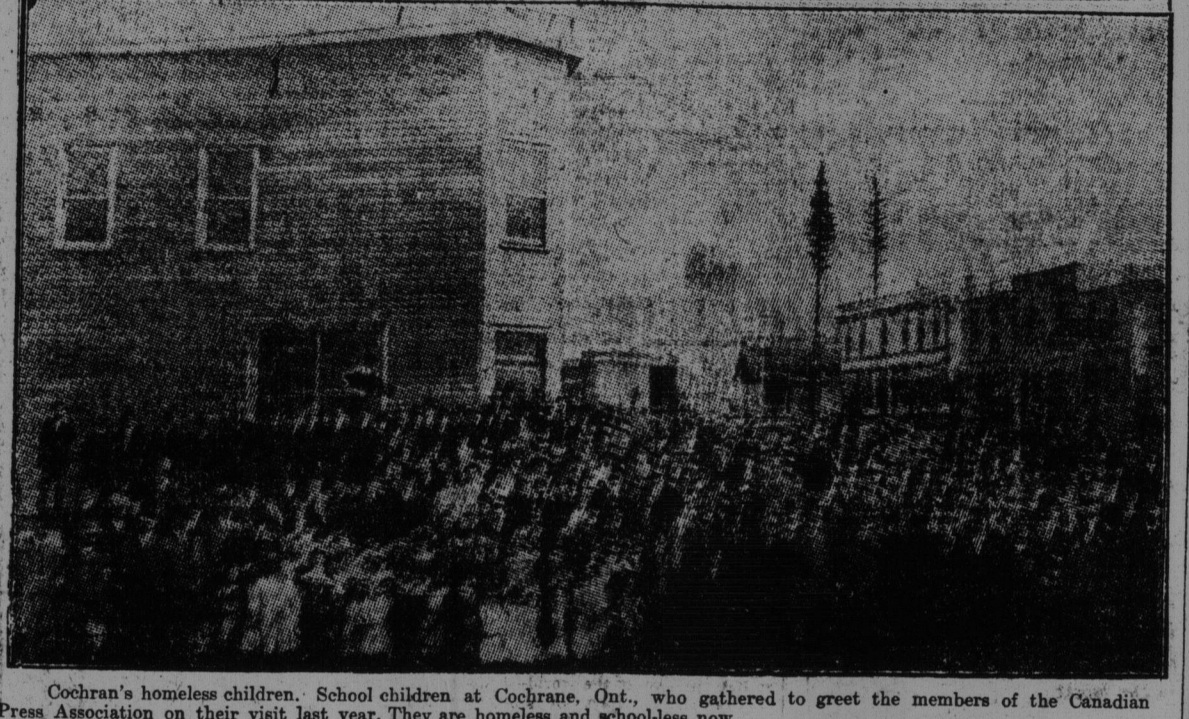

LATE SHIPPING PORT OF ST. JOHN

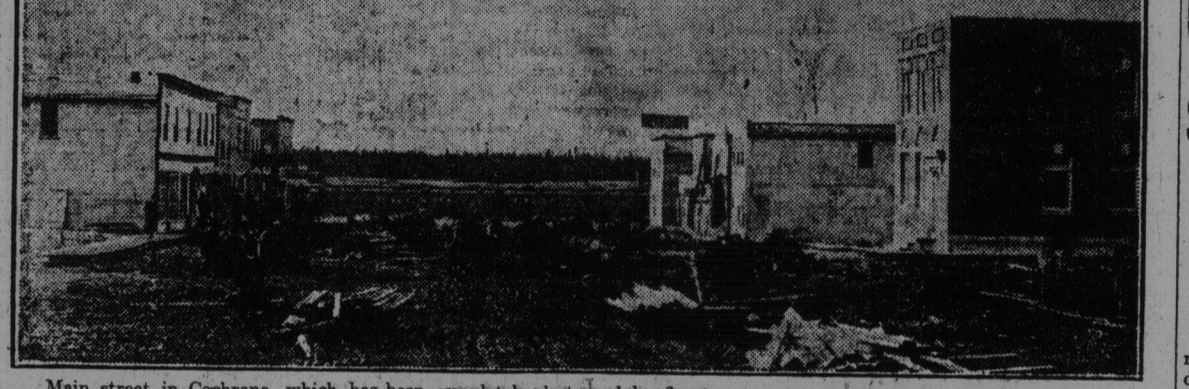

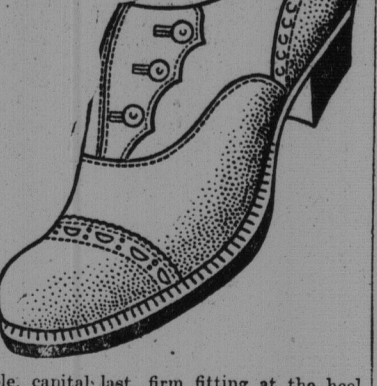
