New Church built at North Huntly. Value not given.

Congregation are at present building a new Church without external aid. They are also about purchasing a Glebe and preparing to build a Manse. This congregation is financially connected with Lanark. Minister gives half his labours to Lanark congregation. People of Darling desirous to build a Church. Some steps taken to effect this desire.

People of Oxford said to be poor, but doing as much for the Church as they can.

New charge. Minister recently inducted. No Churches yet built. Minister has the free use of the Public Hall, in Town of Douglas, and of good School Houses in Townships of Strattan and Wilberforce. A new Church to be erected this year in the latter Township.

\$200.00 in General Sheet No. 1, under "Manse" is the supplement value of "Manse and Glebe." \$280.00 was the Stipend paid to late minister.

One acre of land-site for Manse, value \$200. Number of probable communicants, 150; attendance, 150. Westmeath.—Two acres of land-site for Church, value of \$200. Number of probable communicants, 50; attendance, 150. Stipend to be given at first by congregation of Ross, \$200; by that of Westmeath, \$240.
