THE FRENCH CRISIS.

ALL DEPENDS ON THE ACTION OF THE CHAMBERS TODAY.

It is proposed to dissolve the Chamber and hold a general election in April.

PARIS, Jan. 28.—The cabinet held a meeting this morning and discussed the measure to be adopted in the event of dissolution arising. It is stated that the majority of the ministers favor dissolving the chambers and holding a general election in April, but first modifying the electoral law in order to prevent Parliamentary proceedings. Some members of the Chamber of deputies advocate strong anti-Bonapartist measures by the government. Its president's intention is to call an election for the purpose of settling the responsibility of the situation involved. He will not abandon the presidency until the expiration of his term of office. Minister Floquet has decided to resign or take any other action that the Chamber of deputies might consider the interests of the republic demand.

THEIR MAJESTIES DEFEATED.

But the Position of the Missionaries is Considered More Dangerous.

ZANZIBAR, Jan. 28.—An engagement took place at Dar-Des-Salaam, on Sunday, resulting in the defeat of the Arabs. Many were killed. During the fight, the first lieutenant of the German warship "Sofala" was killed by a musket ball. The position of the captured missionaries is more dangerous. It is reported that the manager of the German Viceconsulate mentioned the friendly natives and read an autograph letter from the Emperor thanking each native by name for his good will and assistance and promising protection and reward. The British consul is trying to arrange an caravan to bring away the missionaries from Ninawaga and Manjuba this position being extremely dangerous.

Only will receive Peace.

ROSE, Jan. 28.—Parliament was opened today by King Humbert. The King alluded to the bills which would be introduced by the government, as eminently pacific in their character. He expressed his conviction that the King said "Italy will continue to work for peace, which all desire and which I can declare will be kept by me."

The East African Bill.

BEIRUT, Jan. 28.—Committee of Beirut which was referred the East African bill has approved the measure. They are in favor of the bill.

Official Report From.

A POLITICAL WATERLOO.

BONAPARTE ELECTED FOR PAIR BY AN IMMENSE MAJORITY.

The Government tender their resignation, but the President will not accept them.

PARIS, Jan. 28.—In consequence of the victory of Bonaparte, yesterday, the ministry tendered their resignations this morning. President Carnot declined to accept them.

The Monarchist papers assert the result of the election a condemnation of a Parliamentary republic and renouveau of the Republic.

Several arrests were made last evening. No serious outbreak occurred. Election held yesterday to fill a vacancy in the Chamber of Deputies for the department, Cote d'Or, M. Barry, Republican candidate, received 25,445 votes, and M. Prost, Radical, 22,723.

PARIS, Jan. 27.—Bonaparte is elected by a plurality of 31,550. The vote was unprecedentedly large. The best of order prevailed at the 200 balloting stations. The whole military force in the city was at the back of the police to suppress any riotous outbreak.

Bonaparte's majority was 60,000 in St. Denis district. He polled three times more votes than his opponent in the 5th arrondissement.

Complete returns show the following results:—

Bonaparte 24,723; Prost 22,723.

Bonaparte spent the evening at Cafe Paradis, where he was welcomed by his friends of the results in the several divisions. The streets are thronged with people excitedly discussing the upshot of the election. Newspaper offices are displaying the returns by means of illuminated signs.

A morning paper engaged 15 special reporters each provided with a cab, and 30 bicyclists to display the results in each section with the greatest possible speed.

Bonaparte predicted the immediate fall of parliament and a general election in March, and a regime in the radical party. They express the belief that 40 radical deputies will join the Bonapartist ranks and thus give the general following the 60 members in the present chamber.

The Bonapartists were everywhere first at the voting places and displayed the greatest confidence.

Bonaparte will resign his office, and resigning that for the Nord department. He is rumored M. Maguin, governor of the Bank of France, will be asked to form a cabinet.

The cabinet sat from 11 p.m. until 1 a.m. Premier Floquet informed President Carnot that the cabinet was prepared to resign. Several ministers advocated a reconstruction of the cabinet on a wider basis.

The Bonapartist organization was unopposed. For the first time in the history of France, carriages were largely employed to convey voters to the polls.

It is computed 100,000 conservatives and as many more radicals and socialists were present at the election.

Lozouet, Jan. 28. In.—The Standard, commenting upon the Paris election, says Paris has done many wonderful things, but never anything more wonderful than the election of Bonaparte, nevertheless the more ignominious or insane. Paris made the war of 1870, and it seems probable she will make another.

NEW YORK, Jan. 28.—The Sun says the election of Bonaparte is a serious, perhaps ominous event for France and for the peace of Europe.
