ARTICLE IV.—COMMITTEES.

The following Committees shall be appointed on the first day of the Annual Meeting:—On Credentials, on Finance, on Resolutions, and on Plan of Work for the ensuing year, the last two to consist of two from each Province chosen by the representatives of that Province.

ARTICLE V.—BUSINESS COMMITTEE.

The Executive Committee shall be the Business Committee of the Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE VI.

All documents and announcements from the Dominion Union shall be sent to the Provincial Union through their respective Corresponding Secretaries.

ARTICLE VII.

The expenses of General Officers (exclusive of Provincial Vice-Presidents) in travelling to and from the Annual Meeting, also for postage and stationery, shall be borne by the Union.

ARTICLE VIII. - SUPERINTENDENTS.

Superintendents shall be nominated by the Executive Committee (excepting Superintendents and Departments) and elected by the Annual Convention. Their election shall be by acclamation, unless otherwise ordered, and the Executive Committee may fill any vacancies occurring in the interim of Annual Meetings.

ARTICLE IX.

At each Annual Meeting a committee shall be appointed on Courtesies of the Convention, to which shall be referred the charge of all introductions to the Convention.

ARTICLE X.

The General Officers shall constitute a Sub-Committee for the speedy transaction of business during the year.

ARTICLE XI.

Crusade Day shall be September 28th, and the Day of Prayer on January 3rd, Mrs. Youman's birthday.

ARTICLE XII.

These By-Laws may be altered or amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present at any Convention.

PLEDGE.

I hereby promise, God helping me, to abstain from all distilled, fermented and malt liquor, including beer, wine and cider, as a beverage, and to employ all proper means to discourage the use of and traffic in the same.
