THE FORTUNE HAY AFFAIR.—The Herold's London special of 22nd says Lord Selkirk's reference to recognize the Justice of the Peace in the American fisherman for \$1,000,000 attacks on them. He takes the ground that the United States fishermen, in drawing their seines from the shore, were transgressing the privileges granted them under the treaty, which does not include the right to land for the purpose of drawing seines from the shore. In fishing with a seine, the American fisherman were violating laws in existence when the treaty was concluded.
