

A second chamber may be either federal or national. Under the federal system of Goverrment it is not absolutely necessary that you should have a federal house created upon a federal basis. You may make it a National Assembly, but in orde: to do so it is necessary that the Crawn abould not be limited with regard to us appointment in any particular provision. If the Senate were not intended to be organized upon a federal basis, then the provisions of our British North American Act (which may be designated our Constitution) providing that Ontario snould be represented by twenty-four persons in the Senate—that Quebec should be represented by twenty-four, have no meaning whatever. I say these provisions have no meaning whatever if it was not intended to be constituted upon a federal basis, it was absolutely necessary that the Provinces which were to be represented in this House should in some way or other control the appointments of those who were to represent them. The English system is one of mutual checks.
