THE MILITIA OF LOWER-CANADA.

IN the army, the recruit is completely drilled before he joins, the battalion; but, as this method requires a great number of persons capable of giving the necessary instructions, it cannot be followed, in this Province, where one single person qualified for that purpose, will be under the necessity of drilling a great number of Militia men: it will therefore be necessary to form the men into platoons before proceeding to drill them.

WHEN the platoon or company is formed, they will be infructed in the exercises and movements, according to these regulations.

THE Officers will meet, at a place agreed upon, where they will be previously instructed in the principles contained in the same.
