L. This Act not to annul any commissions given to Militia Officers previous to its passing.

LI. This clause is repealed.

LII. In case of war or other urgent case, the Governor may assemble the Legislature with a delay of fourteen days.

LIII. By this clause an Act passed in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of His late Majesty George the Third, also an Ordinance passed in the twenty-ninth year, and an Act of the Legislature of this Province passed in the thirty-fourth year, and another Act passed in the thirty sixth year of the reign of His late Majesty George the Third, are by the present Act repealed.

LIV. This Act to be in force until the first day of May, 1823.

ADDITIONAL CLAUSES introduced into the Act of the fifty-ninth year of the reign of His late Majesty George the Third, on the 24th April, 1819, and which make part of the Act of the 43d year, of the 18th April, 1803:
