## BILL.

An Act to prohibit interments in certain grounds in the City of Quebec.

THEREAS it is essential to the salubrity of the City of Quebec, and the health of the inhabitants of the said Preamble. City, that the interment of dead bodies in the burial grounds hereinafter mentioned situated in populous wards of the said 5 City should be prohibited for the future;

Be it enacted, &c., That from and after the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful to inter any dead body in the Interments in Roman Catholic burial ground known by the name of Cimitière grounds in the City of Que-des Picotés, situate in Palace ward in the said City nor in the bec prohi-10 burial ground which surrounds the Parochial Church of the Parish of Notre-Dame de Québec nor in the burial ground known by the name of the English burial ground situate in St. John Street in St. John's Ward in the said City.

II. Every transgression of the provisions of the preceding Penal clause. 15 section of this Act shall be punishable by a fine of pounds currency, recoverable with costs by an action of debt in a Court of competent civil jurisdiction from the Marguillier of the Euvre and Fabrique of the Parish of Notre-Dame de Québec, in the case of an interment in the said Cimetière 20 des Picotés or in the burial ground surrounding the Parochial Church of the said Parish as above mentioned; and in the case of an interment in the said English burial ground the fine shall be recovered from the Trustees of the burial ground.

III. Every action for the recovery of a fine under this Act Actions for pe-25 shall be brought in the name of the Mayor and Councillors of naity in whose name to be the City of Quebec, and proof of the offense shall be made brought and by what eviby the oath of one or more credible witness or witnesses; and dence to be the officers and servants of the said Mayor and Councillors 30 shall be competent witnesses in every such action.

IV. All fines recovered under this Act shall belong to the Application of City of Quebec, and shall be paid to the Treasurer of the said City.
