An Act to amend the Dundas and Waterloo Macadamized Road.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Preamble.
 tolls collected on the Dundas and Waterloo Macadamized Road should be in proportion to the use of the same, but as the
 5 law now stands, this just principle cannot be reduced to practice: Be it therefore enacted,
 &c.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of Notwithstand-
 ing 28th
 Sect. U. C. 3,
 Vict. c. 53.
 10 the same, That for and notwithstanding any thing contained in the twenty-eighth Section of a certain Act of the Legislature of the Province of Upper Canada, passed in the third year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled,
 "An Act to repeal, alter and amend the laws
 15 "now in force for the regulation of the several
 "Macadamized Roads within this Province," it shall and may be lawful for the Commissioners having the management of the said Road and their successors in office, to demand
 20 and collect or authorize to be demanded and collected immediately from and after the passing of this Act, the tolls payable at the gates on the said Road every time of passing the same, or otherwise, as they may deem
 25 advisable. Tolls on Dun-
 das and Wa-
 terloo Road
 may be de-
 manded, every
 time of pass-
 ing.

And be it enacted, That the seventeenth 17th Sect. of
 above Act to
 apply to Com-
 missioners of
 that road.
 Section of the said recited Act shall be held to apply to the Commissioners of the Dun-
 das and Waterloo Macadamized Road, and
 30 under that style or designation they shall and may sue or be sued in the name of their Clerk.
