## BILL

To continue and amend two certain Acts therein-mentioned for the better regulation of the Militia of this Province.

THEREAS it is expedient to amend and further to continue, for a limited time, an Act passed in the forty-third year of the reign of His Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act for the better regulation of the " Militia of this Province, and for repealing "certain Acts or Ordinances therein-mention-" ed," as amended by two several Acts, that is to say, by an Act passed in the fifty-seventh year of His late Majesty's reign aforesaid, intituled, " An Act for reviving and continuing for " a limited time, and amending an Act passed " in the forty-third year of His Majesty's reign, "intituled, "An Act for the better regulation of the Militia of this Province, and for repeal-"ing certain Acts or Ordinances therein-mention-"ed;"—And by an Act passed in the fifty-ninth year of the reign of his late Majesty aforesaid, intituled, " An Act further to continue, for a li-" mited time, and to amend an Act passed in "the forty-third year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the better regulation of " the Militia of this Province, and for repealing " certain Acts or Ordinances therein-mentioned:" Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain " parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year " of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act " for making more effectual provision for the Go-" vernment of the Province of Quebec in North-" America," and to make further provision for " the Government of the said Province;"—and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the above-mentioned Act passed in the forty-third year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for the better regulation of " the Militia of this Province, and for repeal-" ing certain Acts or Ordinances therein-men-"tioned," as amended by the above recited Acts of the fifty-seventh and fifty-ninth years of His late Majesty's Reign, and all and every the
