the Mands of Guernsey, Jersey, and Man, to carry on the Mhale Fishery on the Coasts of Newfoundland and the Seas adjacent, certain Bounties therein mentioned are allowed annually, for a limited Time, to a certain Number of Aesfels which thall be sitted out under the Limitations and Restrictions in the said Act mentioned. which shall take and kill One Whale at the least in the Gulph of Saint Lawrence, or on the Coasts of Labrador, Newfoundland, of in any Seas to the Southward of the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights: And whereas Doubts have arisen, whether Whales taken and killed in northern Latitude Sixty-four Degrees and an Half, are, within the Intent and Weaning of the said Ad, to be deemed to have been taken and killed in any Sea to the Southward of the said Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights; and to obviate such Doubts for the future. it is necessary to explain particularly the Limits of those Seas, and of the Seas adjacent thereto: Way it therefore please your Wajesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Wajetty. by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Tempozal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same. That the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights thall be deemed and taken to extend to the Latitude of Kifty-nine Degrees Thirty Hinutes Morth, and no further; and that the said Bounties, granted and allowed by the faid recited Ad, thail not extend, or be construed to extend, to any Whale that shall be taken and killed in any Sea to the Southward of the said Greenland Seas of Davis's Streights, erceeding Forty= four Degrees of Morth Latitude; any Law, Custom, or Usage, to the contrary notwithkanding.

And whereas, by Reason of the present Possilities, Uessels employed in the Mhale Kisheries are liable to great hazard, and are frequently obliged to wait for Convoy to protest them from Capture by the Enemy, and it is therefore expedient to assom them a longer Time to pursue the said Kisheries, and sor their Return home; sor Remedy whereof, it is hereby surther en-
