

Dear Sir:-

We beg to re-enclose to you an account due us by your department, amounting to \$140.75. The orders for the goods are also enclosed.

These materials were ordered by Agent Matthew Hill, who stated that the lands on which these improvements were made had been leased by the Indian Department with the understanding that these improvements would be made by or at the expense of the Department, and he further stated that a reference to the leases, or to the correspondence in relation to said leases with your Department would bear out his statement in this respect.

We would feel much obliged if you will have this matter carefully looked in to during the ensuing week or ten days, at the expiration of which, we will have our representative call upon you with any further explanation which may be necessary in order that an early settlement of this account may be made with us.-

We mention the week or ten days so that sufficient time may be had to look in to the matter, and if necessary to correspond with Mr. Hill.
