TECHNICAL SUB-COMMITTEE

DRAFT REPORT.

The Technical Sub-Committee of the Committee on Munitions and Food Supplies⁺ has held three meetings.

The Sub-Committee thought it could best approach the task committed to it by endeavouring to ascertain approximately the extent to which the Dominions and India would be likely to make demands on the United Kingdom for armaments and munitions of war in the next three years.

In the cases of the Dominion of New Zealand and the Union of South Africa, it was explained to the Sub-Committee that the extent of the probable demand could not be stated, pending decisions on policy which have not yet been taken.

The probable requirements of India had already been made available in answer to a request made by His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom. The representatives of the Dominion of Canada and the Commonwealth of Australia on the Sub-Committee have
