The amount agreed to be paid for Indian improvements on Lots 13 and 14, Block Y, viz- \$690.00, and the amount agreed to be paid for improvements on S. 1 of Lot 15, Block Y, viz- \$20.00, should be collected and transmitted to the Department with your return of sale, and request made for cheques in the usual way.
