I am enclosing a copy of plan showing the islands which have been claimed by the St. Regis Indians as a part of the hunting grounds of the Iroquois, which were in their possession at the time of the French rule in this country, and guaranteed by the Royal Proclamation of 1763. You might forward this copy of plan to the Deputy Minister of Lands & Forests, Quebec, and inform him that for many years the islands shown on this plan have been dealt with as forming part of the St. Regis Indian reserve.
