Referring to your letter of the 3rd instant, I beg to state that vouchers Nos. 6070 and 6074 in favour of Mr. W. T. Deirnes for harness supplied to ex-pupils cannot be paid until you forward the memorandum required by the War Purchasing Commission regulations showing the names of the firms invited to tender &c. Such memo should accompany all vouchers and there is no reason why it should be withheld in this case until all the articles authorized are purchased.
